Nurse's Notes –

Exclusion Day is coming—Wednesday, February 17, 2021

Even though students are still/or may still be in Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL), Exclusion Day is still coming. It is really important to keep your child/youth's immunizations up to date during these times. If your child/youth is missing any school required immunizations, or if you have not shared recent immunizations with the school, please do so as soon as possible, so that they won't miss any school (includes on-line school) come February.

Parents or guardians will receive a letter from Josephine County Public Health if their child's immunizations are not up to date. Children will not be able to attend school or childcare starting February 17, 2021, if school records show missing immunizations. If you have already obtained the missing immunizations, please share a copy of the record with the school.

Parents seeking immunizations for their children should contact their child's health care provider or the local health department, where they will need to make an appointment (541-474-5325). You can also call Oregon SafeNet at 1-800-SAFENET or 1-800-723-3638 (or call 211). Additional information on school immunizations can be found on the Oregon Public Health web site:
