## Seeking AVID Tutors

**Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID)** is an elective class at Grants Pass High School, North & South Middle School offering rigorous curriculum to promote student achievement. AVID teaches college readiness skills and is available to all students but especially those who would be first generation college students. The program looks for students who are passing their classes, but who can and will earn higher grades with the additional support that will help them in pursuing a college education.



A unique aspect of AVID is the tutorial. AVID tutorials are an outstanding opportunity for interested students, community members, future educators and social service providers to gain experience in working with students in grade 8-11. It is much more than a simple 1:1 tutoring situation, as the AVID tutors run Socratic-style small group sessions and need to exercise teacher like discretions as they facilitate higher level discussion and collaboration. Tutors will also be responsible for grading student's tutorial session, binders and focused notes.

AVID tutors will have the opportunity to work at the following times depending on their schedule:

Monday & Friday – all day at the high school

Tuesday – 1 hour in the AM at the high school and 1 hour in the afternoon at either middle school.

Thursday – 1 hour in the afternoon at either middle school

Tutor positions may be volunteers or paid spots requiring a minimum of two hours per week. Training will take place the last week of August, and it's best to get connected now so that we can secure a position for you.
