

FAQ:

How do I know what my child is supposed to be doing?

Log into Canvas to see each day's assignment. If it's not clear, contact your child's teacher by email or phone. There is also information available in your parent account.

How is attendance counted?

To count as present for the day, a child needs to log into Canvas and participate in class activities.

What if my child cannot log in during "live" times because I am at work?

Contact your child's teacher and let them know. There is always a way to do something even in the off-hours. Remember that something is better than nothing.

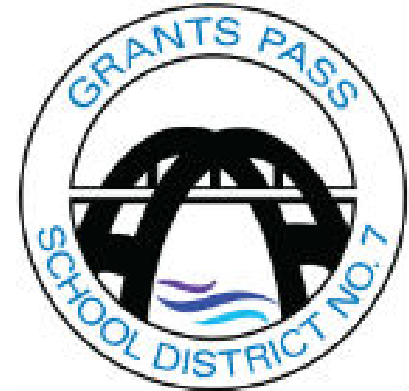

How to log in to a student account:

Using your Chromebook:

1. Log into your District 7 account
2. Canvas will be your student's homepage

To access your Canvas account on any device:

1. Visit grantspass.instructure.com
2. Log on using your D7 account

Using another device

(use the Chrome Browser):

1. Go to www.google.com
2. Log into your student District 7 Google account
3. Canvas will be your student's start page

Tips for Online Learning:

Establish Routines and Expectations:
