- We will report results on the standardized state assessments to parents.
- The Highland Parent/Student/Teacher compact will be made available to all parents. This compact will inform all parties of their responsibilities toward achieving academic success. The form will be included in the school handbook.
- Annual evening events related to literacy and/or math will provide parents educational opportunities as well as the chance to engage with their children.
- Parents will be invited to serve on Site Council which meets regularly. This council will write the school improvement plan, review that plan yearly, approve staff development, and make other recommendations for school improvement.
- Parent volunteers are encouraged upon an approved background check.
